Report on Pulse Polio Drive (April 2, 2017)

Reference to email dated March 29, 2017 from State Liaison Office (NSS), a Pulse Polio Drive was organized by Chandigarh Administration on 2nd April 2017 to administer the Polio vaccine to the children below the age of 5. Sixteen members from the NSS unit of Chandigarh College of Engineering and Technology (Degree Wing) volunteered and helped in the organization of the Polio drive.

The volunteers assembled at the Government Dispensary in sector 20, Chandigarh, at 8:30 am and underwent a training session. The volunteers were then divided into teams consisting of 2 or 3 NSS volunteers and 2 dispensary staff members. The teams put up the posters and the banners at a visible location and set up the vaccine stand, tables and chairs. People brought their children to the vaccination booths where the volunteers administered the doses as instructed. The teams assembled at the Dispensary, sector-20, Chandigarh at 5:00pm where they submitted the reports and were applauded for their efforts to curb the disease.
